
Complete the figured bass below.

Show preparations and resolutions (including delayed resolutions) of all sevenths with arrows; show resolutions of all tendency tones (leading tones and secondary leading tones) with arrows; show resolutions of all augmented fourths and diminished fifths with arrows as well; show tonicizations with arrows from one roman numeral to another as we have been doing in class.

1 point per note; 3 points per roman numeral; 5 points per tonicization; 3 points for each arrow showing preparation and resolution of sevenths, resolutions of tendency tones (leading tones and secondary leading tones and all augmented fourths / diminished fifths); 4 points per cadence.
