| Dr. Grenvil | Bass | Violetta's doctor. He can't do much for her as TB was then incurable. |
| Flora Bervoix | Mezzo-soprano | A friend of Violetta and also one of the great non-parts in opera. Frequently onstage yet never noticed. |
| Gastone | Tenor | A friend of Alfredo's who brings Alfredo to a party so he can meet Violetta. |
| Giorgio Germont | Baritone | The stoically old fashioned father of Alfredo. He comes to understand young love by the conclusion but it takes a lot of pain and suffering from all involved to get him there. |
| Violetta Valéry | Soprano | The heroine of the piece. A courtesan with a heart (think Moulin Rouge) who comes to a predictably sticky end |
